Located in Tamar Valley, Tasmania 41 degrees South and 50 metres above sea level; twenty hectares of vines were established in 1998. This premium Certified Organic vineyard comprises predominantly Pinot Noir and Chardonnay with smaller plantings of Riesling and Pinot Gris. The resulting cool climate wines have naturally higher acid, with a focus on the expression of fruit and texture.

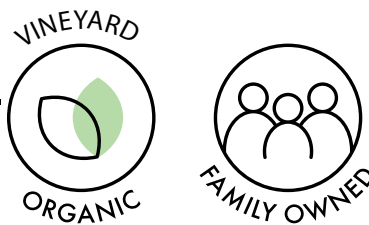
Small Wonder is humble yet aspirational. Our contribution is small, but significant; mindful of our relationships with our communities and our long-term impact on the planet.

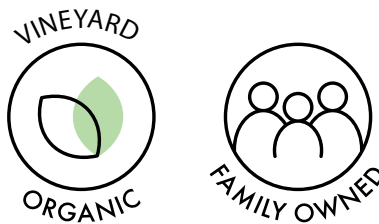


Produced from the Wayfinder Vineyard, located in the heart of the Margaret River Region in Western Australia, 7kms from the Ocean and 100 metres above sea level. 50 hectares of mature vineyard planted between 1998-2002 comprising predominantly Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah. The vineyard became Australian Certified Organic (ACO) in 2022 and is regeneratively managed, supporting native biodiversity as well as bees, sheep and chickens. Swell Season is the reflection of promises kept and the thrill of many more to come.

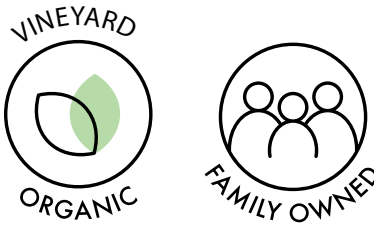
Located in the Margaret River Region in Western Australia, Wayfinder brings a fresh perspective to a region renowned for premium wine. Just 7 kilometres from the Indian Ocean, the mature 50 hectare vineyard has been caringly converted to Certified Organic. Their regenerative approach to the land supports native biodiversity as well as farming bees, sheep, chickens and organic vegetables on the property.

Wayfinder boasts a portfolio of elegant and expressive single varietal wines, with particular focus on Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay, Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Malbec.

BYRNE

BALLARAT & GEELONG, VICTORIA

AUSTRALIA



Byrne has entered a new chapter with this shift from Ballarat to Geelong however, his focus on cool climate Pinot Noir and Chardonnay remains the same. Now based in the Surf coast subregion of Geelong, Byrne Wines are primarily being sourced from the Mount Moriac vineyard. At 250m elevation it is one of the coolest vineyards in the Geelong region and having been established in 1987 it is also one of the most mature. Mount Moriac is an ancient volcanic formation with surface soils of black cracking clays overlaying nutrient rich volcanic soils and basalt.

Also available, his small batch, premium handcrafted 2023 Ballarat Pinot Noir which comes from Mount Coghill vineyard, which is enriched with deep volcanic soils. This excellent cool climate vineyard site, north of Ballarat, at 450m elevation, on the edge of the Great Dividing Range is the signature Pinot Noir that reflects his inspiration from famed French wine region, Burgundy, crafting world class wines right at home.

Byrne wines are small batch, handcrafted, expressible wines with traditional winemaking techniques used. Everything is done by hand!

LARNOOK

MCLAREN VALE, SOUTH AUSTRALIA

Established in 2022 by Alexia and Damon Roberts, Larnook is a small-batch winery rooted in McLaren Vale, where deep sandy soils and maritime breezes shape wines of freshness, texture, and soul. With a combined legacy in viticulture and winemaking, the Roberts’ approach is grounded in sustainability and driven by a desire to create expressive wines that reflect their natural habitat.

Their 2-hectare estate vineyard features vines planted in 1922 and 1999, farmed with minimal intervention, low irrigation, fewer tractor passes, and a deep commitment to biodiversity. This connection to land is at the heart of Larnook’s ethos. Winemaker Alexia Roberts, known for her award-winning work across the region, now channels her decades of experience into a contemporary range of wines that celebrate the diversity of McLaren Vale. Each bottling is crafted with precision, vibrancy, and a quiet reverence for place.

“This drinks somewhat like a happy melding of chenin blanc and refined chardonnay... with flavours in a red and golden apple zone, along with nashi, stone fruit kernel, green almond, lemon oil and white florals. It’s textural... fine-boned and effortless of feel, guided by vital acidity. This is truly excellent.”

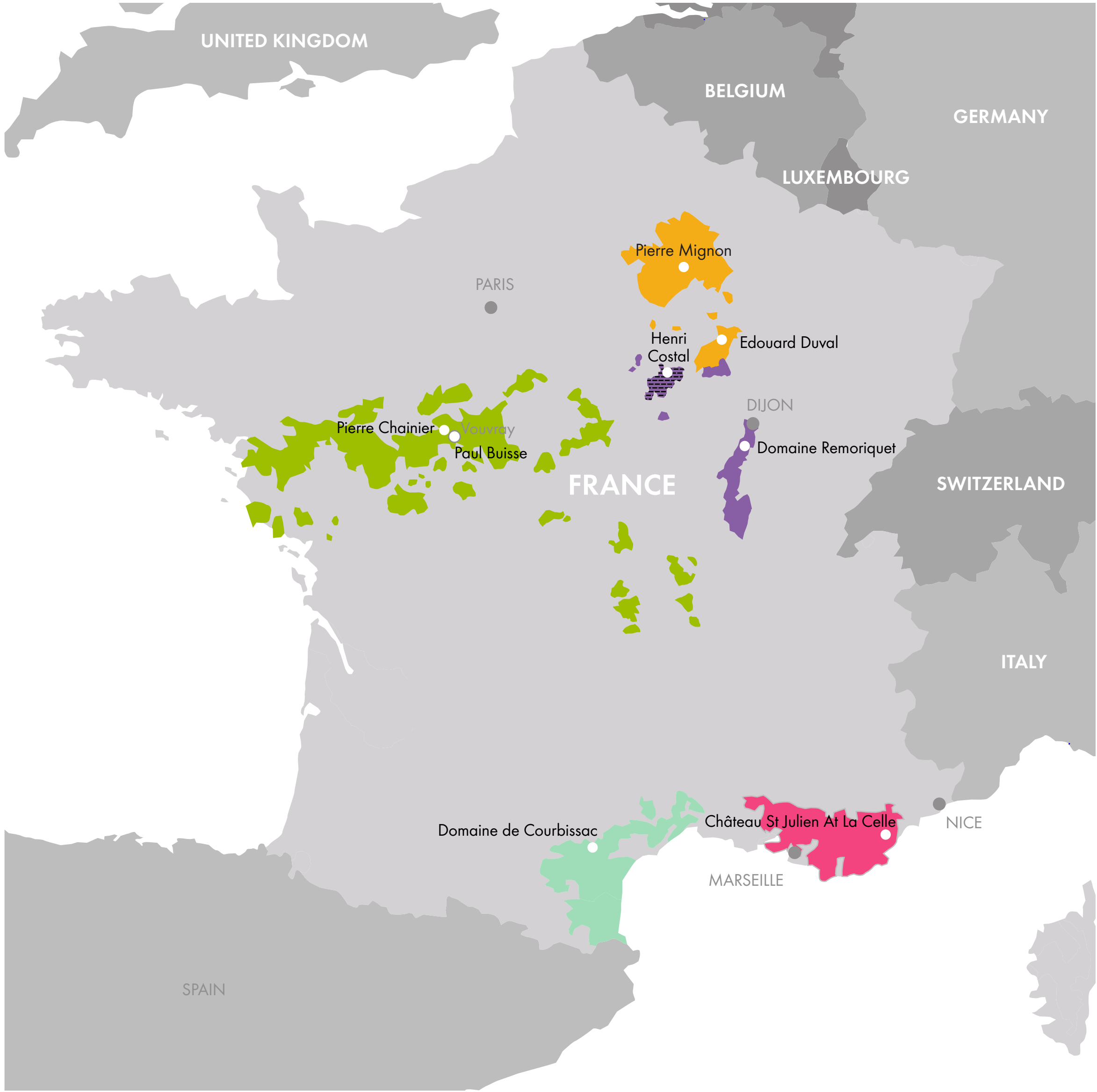

EDOUARD DUVAL
CHAMPAGNE

In the 1950s Charles Roger Duval acquired the Monopole de Sainte Eulalie with an established 28 hectare vineyard planted by the Cluney Abbey monks. South-east-south-west facing, from 190m to more than 300m above sea level, the subsoil is composed of Jurassic slopes, established on Kimmeridgian limestone with a high concentration of oyster fossils “Ostrea Virgula”.

Edouard Duval (Roger’s grandson) took over the reins and since 2015 has been crafting internationally acclaimed Champagnes in his unique style. “Our mission is to make wines that express their terroir, without artifice, convinced that the creation of a great Champagne wine begins in the vineyard. All our Champagnes are made exclusively from grapes coming from our Domaine, where we have been practicing sustainable viticulture for more than 20 years, certified HVE3 and VDC.”

DOMAINE REMORIQUET
CÔTE DE NUITS | BURGUNDY

FRANCE



Domaine Remoriquet, located in Nuits-Saint-Georges, has been family-run for four generations. The estate spans 9.5 hectares, including Premier Cru vineyards in Nuits-Saint-Georges and Vosne-Romanée. Gilles Remoriquet, with over thirty years of winemaking experience, focuses on capturing the essence of each terroir. The winery is committed to environmental sustainability, certified HVE (High Environmental Value) and Terra Vitis. Their wines are known for their finesse and complexity, a testament to meticulous vineyard management and innovative winemaking techniques that honor the rich heritage of Burgundy.

“The Remoriquets were already cultivating vines in the 17th century for the monks of Cîteaux Abbey. Over four generations, they have gradually built up their own plots: 9.5 hectares of vines, notably in Nuits-Saint-Georges and Vosne-Romanée. A trained oenologist, Gilles Remoriquet has been at the helm since 1979.” Le Guide Hachette des Vins

CHÂTEAU ST JULIEN AT LA CELLE

The Saint-Julien Estate extends over 427 hectares of forests, crops, and vines, straddling the communes of La Celle and Tourves, in the French department of Var, at the foot of La Loube, a rocky mountain peak.

The origin of the estate dates back to the Gallo-Roman times with the ruins of a villa discovered when the land was initially developed. In 1989, Mr Maurice Garrassin, enthralled by the beauty of the place, purchased the property, and undertook its renovation into a 28-hectare-estate.

Since 2001, his children Geneviève and Norbert have continued their father’s work and have led the Domaine Saint Julien further along the road to success. The vines are cultivated with the greatest respect of the environment, maintaining traditional expertise, and guaranteeing wines of elegance and character, year after year.

The estate’s vineyards, nestled in the rugged terrain of Minervois, benefit from the region’s sunny Mediterranean climate and diverse soils, which impart unique character to their wines. Specializing in varieties like Grenache, Syrah, and Carignan, Domaine de Courbissac crafts expressive, terroir-driven wines that showcase the complexity and richness of Languedoc. Their commitment to minimal intervention in both vineyard and cellar ensures that each bottle reflects the pure essence of the land and the traditional winemaking heritage of the region.

HENRI COSTAL
CHABLIS | BURGUNDY

Established in 1920 by Henri Costal, this historic Chablis domaine is rooted in a century-long legacy of organic farming and artisanal precision. Henri, a pioneer in sustainable viticulture, believed that great wines begin with living soils, a conviction that continues to shape the domaine’s philosophy today.

Across generations, the estate has remained a family affair. From Henri’s daughter Janine and her husband Jean to their son Gilles, and now Romain, Henri’s great-grandson, each generation has nurtured the vineyards with the same reverence for the land and its rhythms. Under Romain’s care, the domaine enters a new chapter, one that honours tradition while embracing thoughtful evolution. Today, Domaine Henri Costal is united with Domaine Jean Collet, Romain’s ancestral vineyards, forming a cohesive expression of Chablis terroir.

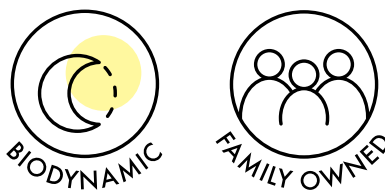
Borgoluce is a 1000-hectare estate in the hills of the Province of Treviso, between Venice and the Dolomites. Ninni and Caterina di Collalto, together with their mother Trinidad and Caterina’s husband, Lodovico Giustiniani, form the founding nucleus from which Borgoluce originated. “We cultivate respect for the land” is not just a slogan; it is a way of being that goes beyond their agricultural production.

Preserving the equilibrium of both the landscape and the environment is the basis of their philosophy, producing wine and food products. They employ the principles of organic and biodynamic farming, paying close attention to water and waste and utilising clean energy.

“There’s a softening creamy texture and the fruit intensity gives a sensation of sweetness in addition to the actual sweetness so the overall effect is medium dry.”

COFFELE
SOAVE | VENETO

ITALY



Coffele, founded in 1971, is based within the historical town walls of Soave and is best known for the production of Soave Classico from their 25 hectares of prime terroir in Castelcerino, 6 km north of the town of Soave. Coffele boast the highest altitude vineyards within the Soave DOC zone. They rise up to 400 meters above sea level and are certified organic or ‘biologico’

The two examples of Soave Classico featured in this portfolio are the Castel Cerino Soave Classico, 100% Garganega that is subtle, fresh and perfectly balanced and the Ca’ Visco Soave Classico, a 75% Garganega / 25% Trebbiano di Soave selection from the best vines on the estate – a wine with layers of flavour, crisp acidity, peppery notes and light minerality. Lesser known is their delicious Valpolicella from the hills of Cazzano di Tramigna, approximately 8 km northwest of Soave.

“Bright straw yellow. A bit restrained on the nose at first, then notes of acacia flowers, light honey, pear and toasted hazelnut. 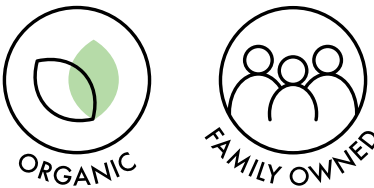


LA SPIA
VALTELLINA | LOMBARDY



Among the terraced vineyards of Valtellina was born “La Spia” (The Spy), a name linked to the homonymous rocky ridge located in the Sassella DOCG sub-area, a sighting and control post dating back to the Grisons domination. In 1962 the property passed to the Rigamonti family who used it for vineyard cultivation, Nebbiolo variety, Chiavennasca biotype. Today La Spia works 4.5 hectares scattered throughout the Valtellina area, producing over 25,000 bottles a year.

La Spia is a young and dynamic cellar, which combines the passion and care of the past with technique and innovation. Their philosophy allows the creation of new Rhaetian gems, such as 100% Nebbiolo vinified and aged in wood, 100% Classic Method Nebbiolo, and the “Castelàsc” project - a blend of Nebbiolo, Moscato Giallo Trentino and Sauvignon Blanc.

TENUTE SELLA
NORTHERN PIEDMONT

ITALY



Tenute Sella is located at the foot of the Alps of Biella, in Northern Piedmont. Purchased in 1671 by Comino Sella, for 350 years the family-owned property has been cultivated by generations of the Sella family. Crafting beautiful, ethereal expressions of Nebbiolo-based wines, Tenuta Sella prides itself on its refined, fragrant and exceptionally age-worthy Alto-Piemonte style.

Today, Tenute Sella is made up of 23 hectares of vineyard in the Piemonte DOC. Their first vineyards were planted in Lessona, following which the family extended their estate to include vineyards in Bramaterra and Coste della Sesia. The estate’s philosophy is founded on re-establishing the importance of their unique terroir and maintaining maximum respect for tradition. Their sustainable approach is based on nurturing the soil, integrated viticulture and safeguarding biodiversity. Each vineyard is hand-picked and vinified separately, using traditional production methods of the region. Dynamic young winemaker Riccardo Giovannini brings new energy and a fresh outlook to the winery, ensuring a resurgence in these wines and the areas from which they come.

LE FONTI
TUSCANY

ITALY



Halfway between Florence and Siena, in the heart of the Chianti Classico region, lies the small village of Panzano. Just below the village church, at 450m above sea level, is the Fattoria Le Fonti. It extends over 15 hectares (37 acres); 9 hectares (23 acres) are vineyards and the rest olive groves.

“The roots of a great wine are found in the vineyard and we strive to keep them in balance by farming sustainably (organic). Thanks to our relative small size we can follow the production with great care: only the best grapes arrive in the cellar and only the best selections are bottled in the end. Since 1994 all the vineyards have been replanted with selected rootstocks and plants adapted to our area, elevation and soil type. The vineyards are farmed organically to save the integrity of the environment. We strongly believe that a great wine starts in the vineyard and thus take meticulous care of our vines and select only the best grapes for the cellar.” - Schmitt-Vitali Family

VILLA RAIANO
CAMPANIA

Villa Raiano, established in 1996 in the Irpinia region of Campania, focuses on crafting premium wines from indigenous grape varieties like Fiano, Greco, and Aglianico grown across three DOCGs. The vineyard spans over 20 hectares, all organically farmed and divided among various vineyard sites that benefit from volcanic soils and diverse microclimates. Their approach emphasizes sustainability and respect for tradition, incorporating modern techniques to enhance the natural characteristics of the grapes. Villa Raiano’s cellar combines gravity-fed winemaking processes and meticulous vinification practices to produce wines that reflect the unique terroir of Campania, marked by elegance and complexity.

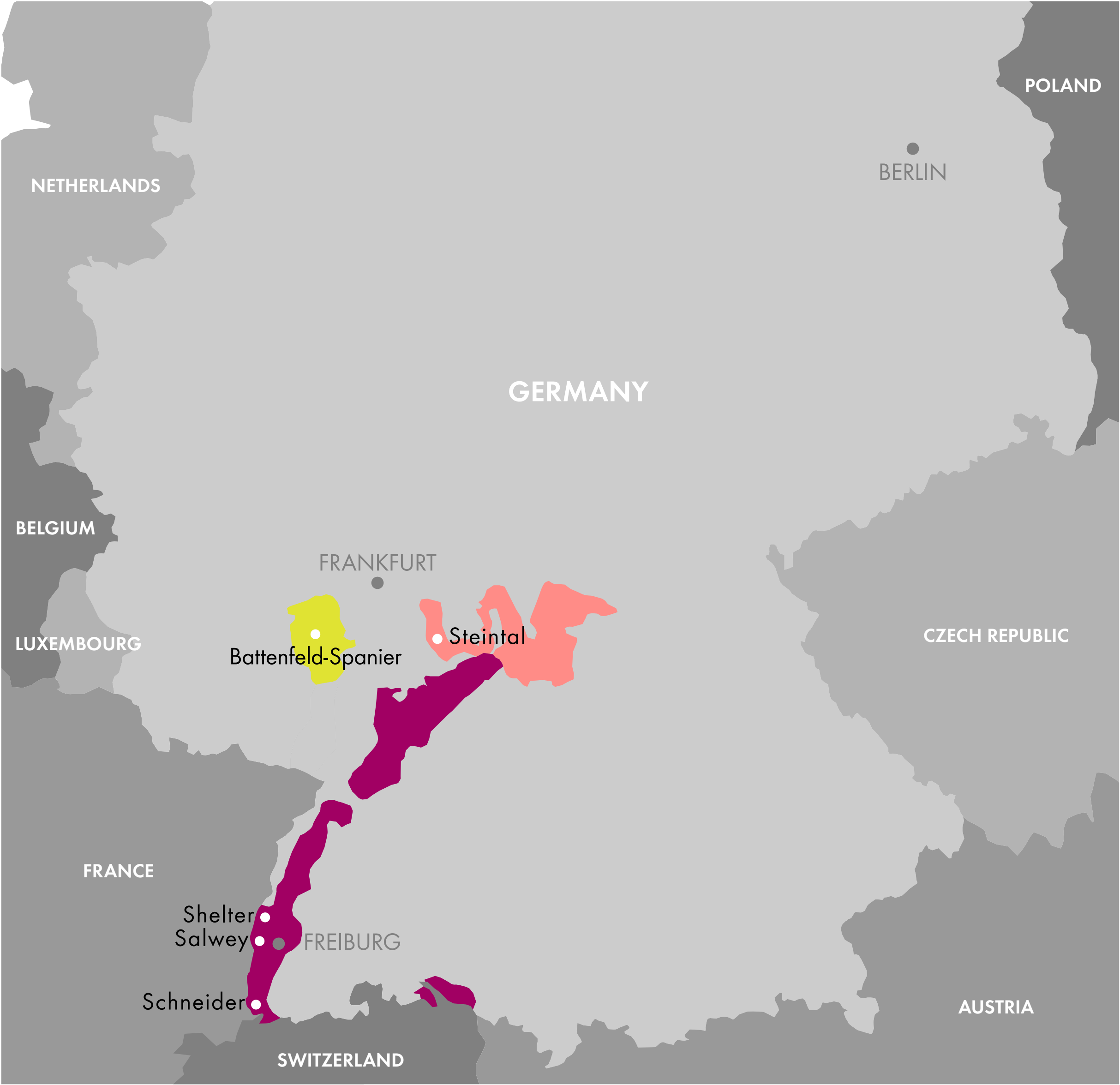

Weingut Schneider hold six hectares in the Weiler Schlipf, the most south-westerly single vineyard site in Germany, directly on the Swiss border. This Weiler Schlipf is in danger of disappearing, the soil consisting of impermeable sandstone slabs covered by a layer of limestone and clay. This steep slope is slowly sliding (in local dialect: “schlipft”) down.

We, Hans-Bert Espe from Osterode and Silke Wolf from Paderborn, studied in Geisenheim because of our love for special wine. Knowledge-expanding stays all over the world have shaped our philosophy, which forms the basis for us today. Our vineyards are located in Kenzingen and Malterdingen. We carefully care for them by hand in order to harvest healthy grapes. We pick by hand bring the grapes quickly to our 'shelter'. Once there, the grapes are processed in the most gentle way. We do without pumps and filters. Our pump is gravity and patience replaces the filter.

The vineyards of Hans-Bert and Silke are north of the Kaiserstuhl. Although only about thirty minutes north, their location enjoys a much cooler microclimate thanks to their proximity to the Black Forest. In addition, the volcanic soils of the Kaiserstuhl give way to limestone and loess. The result is Pinot Noirs with lower alcohols and higher acidities.

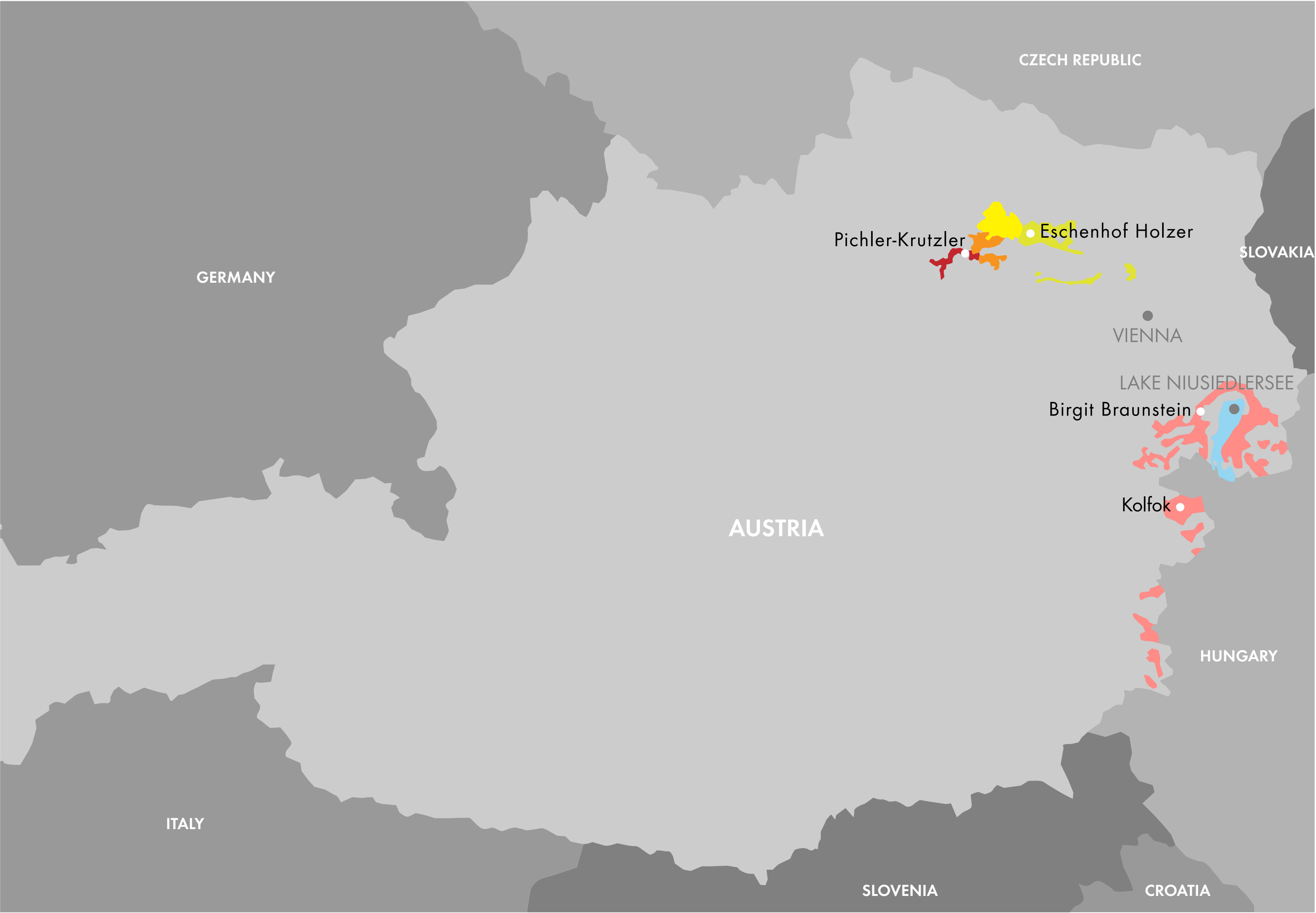

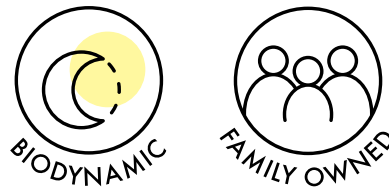

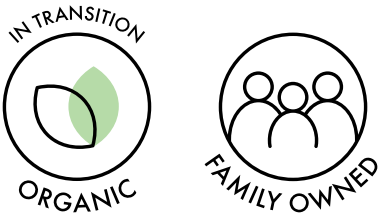

On the 16 hectare estate Arnold draws on the unique bounty of nature; with a great deal of creativity, a distinctive style and a sense for delicious creations! Arnold has a focus on Grüner Veltliner, with his wines enriched with the typical regional features, but also offering a completely unique profile. The loess soil drifted here in multiple layers during the last ice age lending valuable mineral composition to the vineyards.

The word Kolfok has its origins in a regional dialect and describes a person, critical of common thoughts - an unconventional thinker. Winemaker and Kolfok in-chief Stefan Wellanschitz was born into wine making at the family’s estate in Neckenmarkt, a winery that dates back to the early 19th century, to a time when this part of Burgenland was still Hungarian and not Austrian. While still also working at the family’s estate, Stefan decided to launch his own wines back in 2013, wines that are a clear deviation from the family’s more traditional style, towards natural wine making and a purist low-tech approach that would highlight soils and micro-climate, aka terroir.

Says Stefan: “I want to show those exceptional conditions in my wines. That’s why I work natural both in the vineyards and in the cellar. To prevent mono culture the vines are growing organically together with other herbs and plants. In the cellar it’s very easy - the wine are pressed without the use of pumps into local oak barrels which can be from 600 liters (Halbstueck) to 1200 liters (Stueck), this is where the wine stays without filtering, moving or even sulfuring. At the optimum time they are bottled unfiltered with a minimal addition of sulfur.”

Pichler-Krutzler from Austria’s famed Wachau region is Erich Krutzler and his wife Elisabeth Pichler-Krutzler, the son-in-law and daughter of F.X. Pichler. Erich is a talented winemaker in his own right, having inherited a Blaufränkisch vineyard in Südburgenland where he was an award winning winemaker for several years. Because Erich has a vineyard of Blaufränkisch in the Südburgenland, they are not members of Vinea Wachau Nobilis Districtus which gives Erich greater flexibility in Pichler-Krutzler’s vinification.

Their sustainable approach to viticulture ensures the gently tilled soils of their 10 hectares of vines are free from insecticides and use only organic manure as fertilizer. In the vinification, indigenous yeasts are used for cuvées, except in an occasional year for the spring-bottled wines. For Supperin, Loibenberg, Pfaffenberg, Kellerberg, fermentation is done with indigenous yeasts in wood foudre from Stockinger of varying sizes up to 1500l, between 1 and 8 years, no toast.
